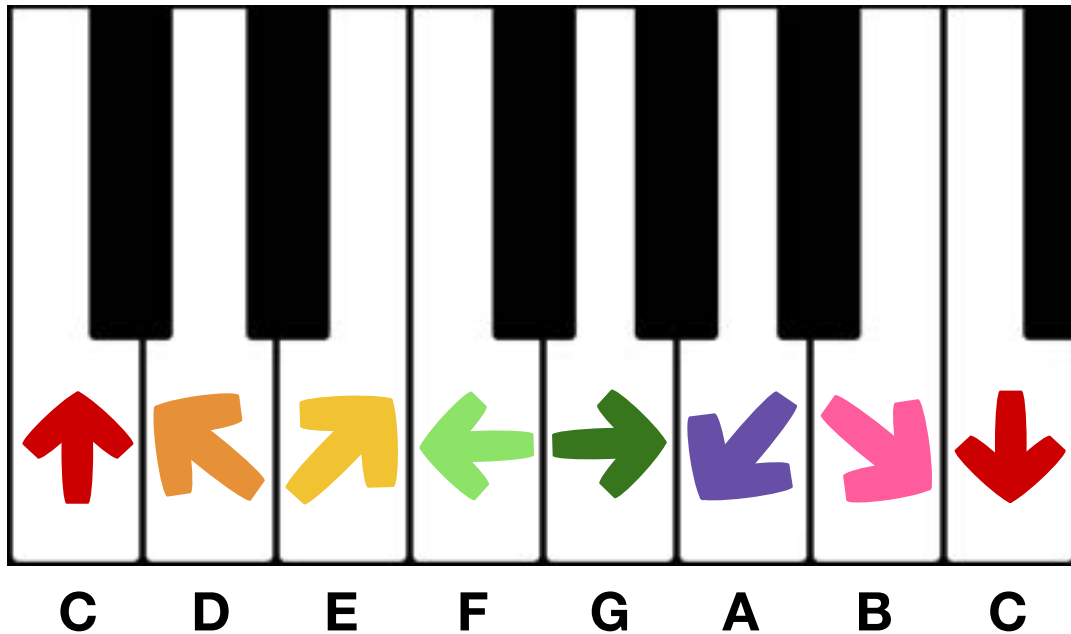


Arrownotes Intro



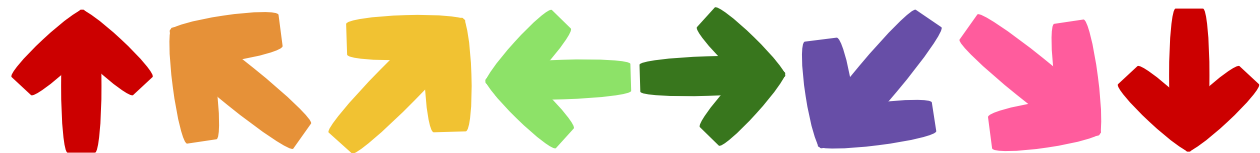
Each white note of the piano has an arrow on it. The arrows tell you which notes you are playing.



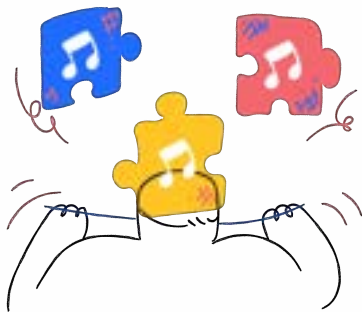
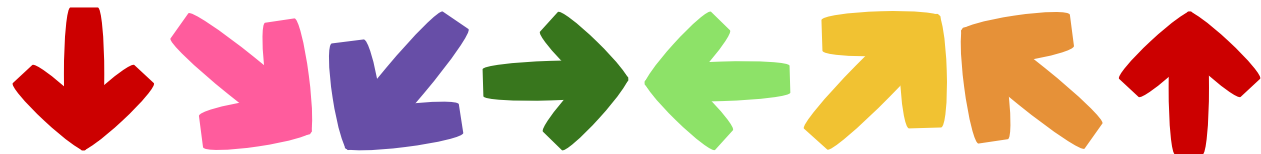

First play these notes...

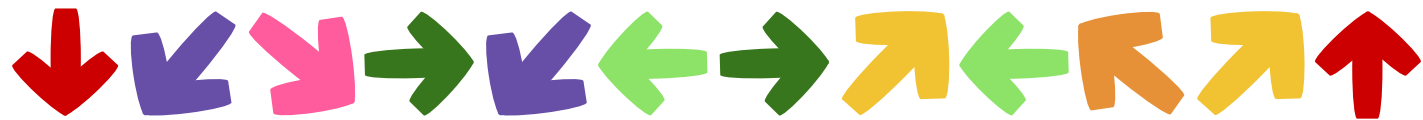


...and now play the exact same notes, but in reverse order

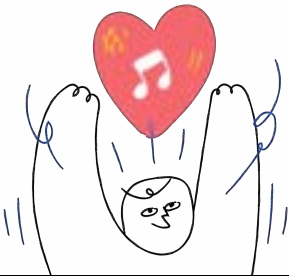
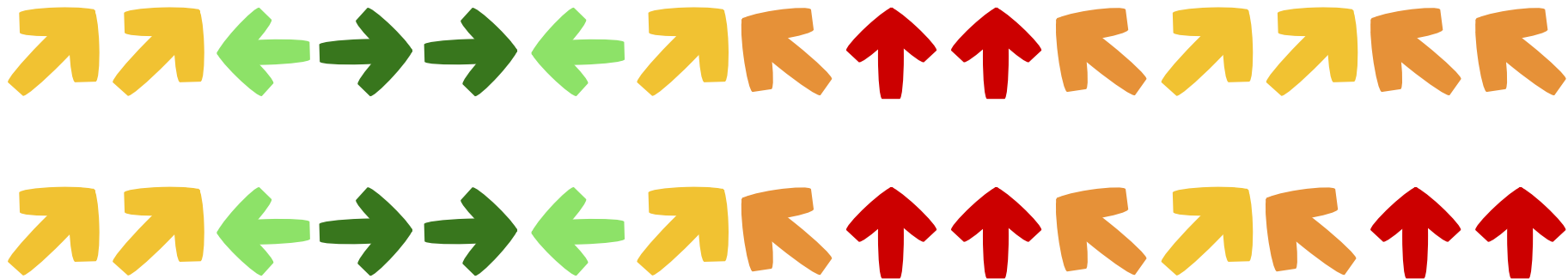
Morning
