



SOP: Using the Swipe Web App

Purpose:

This SOP explains how to access, configure, log into, and run sessions from the Swipe Web App built into the Teaching Portal, including naming sessions and ending them correctly.

Pre-requisites:

- Digit Music Portal account (email + password)
 - Access to the **Teaching Portal** (aqua green highlight box)
 - Students with devices ready to join sessions
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Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Open the Swipe Web App

- Ensure you are in the Teaching Portal (look for the **aqua green highlight box**).
- Click the **blue circle** in the bottom right corner of the screen.
- When you see the **Digit Music logo**, click it to open the playing interface.

2. Resize and Position the Window

- Grab the **bottom right corner** of the window and drag down until you see the **octave buttons** appear.
- Move the window to a convenient location on your screen (e.g. left side if you want lesson content visible in the middle).
- You can:
 - Minimize/expand the app as needed.
 - Enter **full-screen mode** (ideal for demonstrating on an interactive whiteboard).

- Exit full-screen to return to the smaller window.

3. Refresh or Reopen if Needed

- Clicking the **refresh button** reloads the app, but you will have to log in again.
- If you close the app (X), you'll need to repeat the open and login process.

4. Log In to the App

- Click the **Settings (gear) icon** → choose **Sign In**.
- Enter the **same email and password** you used for the portal.
- Click **Login**.
- Once logged in, you'll see a **green MIDI icon** at the top — this must stay green for sound to work.
- If clicked accidentally and turned grey, click it again to re-enable audio.

5. Start a Session

- Go back to **Settings** → choose **Session** → click **Start Session**.
- A unique session is created, displaying a **QR code** and **PIN code**.
- Students can join by:
 - Scanning the QR code OR
 - **Entering the PIN code** (recommended for speed).

6. Edit Session Details (Optional)

- Click **Edit Details** to rename the session with a meaningful name (e.g. *Class J3A – Tuesday AM*).
- Add notes if needed.
- Click **Save** — this helps when reviewing session data later.

7. Deliver the Lesson

- Minimize the app if you want to focus on the lesson content.
- Select the relevant **Unit of Work** and lesson to teach.
- Use the Swipe Web App to demonstrate concepts or perform from the front of the class (especially effective with a touchscreen display).
- Complete the guided video slides, quizzes, and activities with students.

8. End the Session

- When finished, go back to **Settings** → **Session** → click **End**.
- Confirm you want to end the session.
- This will:
 - Save all session data for later access.
 - Automatically log students out, ensuring a fresh start next time.

Tips & Common Mistakes:

-  Always resize the window the first time so all controls (octaves, settings) are visible.
-  Use **PIN codes** for faster joining (QR codes can slow down the start of the lesson).
-  Name sessions clearly — makes reviewing data much easier.
-  Remember to keep the **MIDI icon green** — no sound will play if it's grey.
-  Always **end the session** rather than just closing the app — this ensures clean data tracking and logs students out.
