The best thing – you don't need any musical experience to teach it! Digit Music gives classroom teachers the confidence and tools to lead creative music making, whether they have a musical background or not.



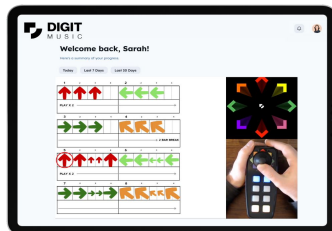

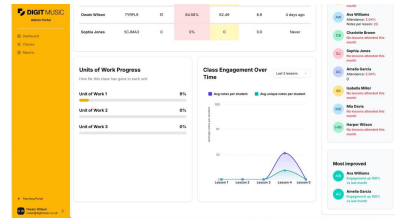
1 – Every child can play
